

This project is a 14-acre addition to the El Ranchito campsite at Shield Ranch that serves children from low-income families. The scope includes a 4,900 sf pavilion for community gathering, 18 cabins totaling 5,900 sf, a mile of asphalt roadway, and several miles of gravel trails.

This campsite is off-the-grid and completely self-sustainable, with all electricity coming from solar panels and all water collected from rain and filtered on site.

It is one of the first projects in Texas to receive SITES Gold Certification for sustainability and resilient land development.
